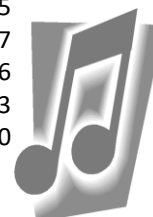

Kent McWilliams – Piano I



Kent McWilliams, Director of the Kent State School of Music, has enjoyed a successful performing career since his debut in Rachmaninov's Piano Third Concerto with the University of Toronto Symphony Orchestra. He has been an award winner at competitions of Porto (Portugal), the Regina Symphony and the Canadian National Competitive Festival of Music. Kent has also performed live recitals and concertos on the CBC in Canada and the ABC in Australia. He has released several recordings, including a recent album with trumpeter Martin Hodel as well as a CD for Albany Records titled, *"East Meets West: Music for Clarinet and Piano by Chinese Composers"* with clarinetist Jun Qian.

Kent holds a Doctorate in Piano Performance from the University of Montreal where he studied with Marc Durand. Kent also earned an Artist Diploma at the Musikhochschule in Stuttgart, Germany and completed Bachelor's and Master's degrees at the University of Toronto. Prior to his arrival at Kent State in July, 2019, he served as the Associate Dean of Fine Arts at St. Olaf College in Minnesota, where he also worked as a piano professor for 18 years.

Dr. McWilliams has judged the national finals of the MTNA competition and the Canadian Music Competitions. He has also judged the Canadian Chopin Festival Competition as well as numerous regional competitions and the MTNA auditions in 25 states and provinces. Kent has been an adjudicator for the Royal Conservatory of Music for over 20 years.

Cherith Alexander – Piano II



Cherith Alexander is a dynamic pianist based in Weyburn, Saskatchewan. As a respected piano and theory teacher in the community for over twenty years she has worked with a variety of students of all ages and levels. Many of her students have received awards including RCM gold medals and provincial music festival honors. In 2011 her pupil Meagan Milatz was the grand prize winner in the Canadian Federation of Music Teachers' Association piano competition.

Cherith is employed part-time as an accompanist/coach at the Conservatory of Music in Regina. Cherith has travelled ten times to the National Music Festival as an accompanying pianist for the Saskatchewan competitors. In 2015 she was delighted to perform as a guest pianist with the Regina Symphony Orchestra Chamber Players.

Cherith is passionate about the value of music festivals and has had the privilege of adjudicating at festivals throughout Western Canada. In 2017 she developed the curriculum for and facilitated the first "Adjudicator Boot Camp" in Saskatchewan which is a workshop designed to train and inspire new and current adjudicators in her province.

Cherith was educated at the University of British Columbia where she was a pupil of Kum Sing Lee. As a young student she was honoured to win the SMFA Concerto Competition in 1991 after which she performed as a guest soloist with the Regina Symphony Orchestra.

Camilla Burgess - Speech



Camilla Burgess is the owner of Viva Voce Speech Arts studio in Vancouver, BC, where she teaches voice, speech and drama to students of all ages. She has more than ten years experience in Speech Arts, as a teacher, student, and adjudicator. Camilla holds an ATCL in Speech and Drama from Trinity College London, and an ARCT in Speech Arts from the Royal Conservatory of Music. Camilla studied at Canada's National Voice Intensive, under Canada's foremost voice, movement and Shakespeare teachers, and continues to expand her knowledge and skills through voice and acting classes and workshops.

Camilla's work is based on the principles of Kristin Linklater, Patsy Rodenburg, and Authentic Movement. Camilla holds an ESL teacher certification (CELTA) and has six years of experience working with ESL speakers, helping them speak with greater clarity, fluency and ease. She also holds a Bachelor of Arts Honours from Queen's University.

Marion Abbott is a proud graduate of the Musical Theatre Performance Program at Sheridan College. Upon graduating, she was immediately hired to teach for the program and was later named one of the top twenty graduates of the program. She has her Grade 10 Voice and A.R.C.T. in Piano Performance from The Royal Conservatory of Music.

Marion produced over 400 productions in Toronto and other cities. Of the many (many!) shows Marion has worked on, some of her favourites include *The Scarlet Pimpernel*, *All Shook Up*, *Anne And Maud*, *No Safe Harbour*, *Ragtime*, *Streetcar Named Desire* and *Passion*. As a private teacher, Marion has taught voice, piano and acting for 31 years to students of all ages. From festivals to recitals to performing in Disney World, Marion cherishes her memories of her time with her students dearly. Many of her former students now work in the arts full time.

Marion is in demand as a director-music director, consultant, adjudicator and private coach. She has also uploaded over 500 accompaniment tracks on her YouTube Channel for Singers/ Voice Teachers to utilize: www.youtube.com/c/MarionAbbott/Videos.

Christianne Rushton – Vocals

Mezzo-soprano **Christianne Rushton** has delighted audiences with her engaging presence and versatility on both the operatic and concert stages. Highlights from recent seasons include a return engagement with both Symphony Nova Scotia and the Newfoundland Symphony Orchestra in performances of Bach's B Minor Mass, Mozart's Requiem, and Handel's Messiah. She also made a recent guest appearance, recording, and tour with the Canadian Chamber Choir as soloist in their world premiere of Jeff Enns' *At Sunset*. Highlights of Christianne's numerous operatic roles have included, Orpheus in *Orpheus ed Euridice* (Opera Nova Scotia), the title role in Ravel's *L'Enfant et les Sortilèges* (Juilliard Opera Center), Cherubino in Mozart's *Le Nozze di Figaro* (Opera North), and Filotea in the North American premiere and Italian revival (Spoleto) of Handel's *Oreste* (Juilliard Opera Center).

Christianne is a past first prize winner of the Canadian Music Festival, a second prize winner of the prestigious Eckhardt-Gramatté Competition, a two-time grant recipient from the Canada Council for the Performing Arts, and a winner of the Canada Council's Bernard Diamant Prize in Voice. In recital, she has performed as guest artist for the Royal Society of Canada, toured with Debut Atlantic, sung at the Indian River Festival, and performed at New York's Alice Tully Hall.

Christianne is Associate Professor at Acadia University where she is head of vocal studies. At Acadia, she has performed with the University Chorus in Bach's Christmas Oratorio, with the Shattering the Silence music festival, and with the annual Tom Regan Memorial Concert. Christianne recently completed her Doctor of Musical Arts degree from SUNY Stony Brook.



Robin Norman – Jr. Vocals & Jr. Musical Theatre

Robin is an active voice teacher, performer and director. She has been teaching voice for over 25 years and has performed in or been the musical director of many different musical productions including *Les Misérables*, *Nunsense* and *Legally Blonde*. She is an active member of the Prince George Arts community, often volunteering her performance and professional services.

Robin has served on several boards, including Performing Arts BC, The Federation of Canadian Music Festivals, Theatre BC, and the Prince George Music Festival, as well as adjudicated on many occasions throughout Canada.

Her choir Nove Voce has been recognized provincially and nationally in festival competitions. They were honored to be name best overall choir in BC in 2016 and 2019 and to have won the Barbara Hagerman Class in the National Festival in 2019. She is exceptionally proud of her students, many of whom have gone on to professional careers in music, performance, and teaching.



Chandelle Rimmer – Contemporary Vocals

Chandelle Rimmer is an internationally recognized music educator, clinician and adjudicator in voice, jazz and contemporary popular music. She is Assistant Professor of Music and Section Head of Voice at MacEwan University, Edmonton, AB, Canada. Chandelle works exclusively in jazz and contemporary popular music, enabling vocalists to find freedom and technical expertise for optimal stage performance. Chandelle received a Bachelor's Degree in Vocal Performance at Berklee College of Music in Boston and a Master's Degree in Music Education from Boston University.

As a performer, Chandelle is a Canadian jazz singer noted for her proficiency as an improviser and outstanding vocal abilities. In 2012, Chandelle released her debut CD *Perspect-ism* and recently released *Stillness Falls* on Bent River Records (2018), a collaborative compositional project with MacEwan University faculty and Canadian jazz pianist, Tom Van Seters.



Philip Candelaria – Guitar

Philip Candelaria teaches at the University of Ottawa. He holds a Bachelor's degree in Music History from the University of British Columbia and a Master's degree in Guitar Performance from the Peabody Conservatory of Johns Hopkins University. Philip has won national and international competitions in Canada.

Candelaria's solo albums have been described as "dazzling" (Canada Music Magazine), "distinguished" (High Fidelity Magazine - USA), and "masterful" (GFA Soundboard - USA). Philip Candelaria has recorded with the G8 guitar octet, the Guitars Alive Quartet, and the Canadian Guitar Quartet, a world-renowned ensemble he founded in 1998. His most recent album recorded with the Guitars Alive Quartet, was released in April of 2019.

Philip's performing career has taken him across Canada and the USA, throughout Mexico, Central and South America, to Europe and the Middle East..

Leanne Zacharias – Cello / Chamber



Cellist Leanne Zacharias' approach to musical life has been compared to extreme sport— from soloist to collaborating across genres with choreographers, writers, architects, visual artists and musicians of all stripes, she has emerged with a uniquely vibrant and contemporary voice. A versatile performer, her debut solo album will be released in 2021 on Redshift Records, with support from the Canada Council for the Arts. A strong advocate for the new, Dr. Zacharias has premiered dozens of compositions, commissioned several handfuls, and worked with leading composers. As a curator, she has designed unique performances for the International Cello Festival, the Winnipeg Design Festival, and in the Canadian Museum of Human Rights as part of the Winnipeg Symphony Orchestra's New Music Festival.

Dr. Zacharias has been Brandon University's cello professor since 2008. An energetic teacher, she is popular as a guest lecturer and adjudicator, including at the Domaine Forget International Music Academy, Rosamunde Academy, Prairie Cello Institute, the Whistler Music Festival, Regina Music Festival, Saskatoon Music Festival, Cadenza Summer Festival among others. She co-directs A Wild Studio, a summer workshop held in Canadian National Parks, and the Hybrid Intensive workshop in San Francisco.

Originally from Morden, Manitoba, Dr. Zacharias studied with Arek Tesarczyk and Paul Marleyn at the University of Manitoba before receiving a Masters Degree from Rice University's Shepherd School of Music. She received her Doctorate from the University of Texas at Austin. While there, she was a company member of the American Repertory Ensemble, the Movable Feast performance collective, and worked closely with Josh Gindele of the Miro Quartet and musicologist Phil Ford.

Christopher Norton – Music Composition

Composer, arranger, educationalist and producer, Christopher Norton is universally regarded as the leader in his field. Born in 1953, he is a New Zealand-born, now Canadian-based pianist and composer. His long and fruitful association with Boosey & Hawkes has resulted in the world-famous *Microjazz series*. Since 2007 he has written *Connections for Piano* for the RCM and *American Popular Piano* for Novus Via Publications.

He is in high demand for his unique and creative presentations. He offers sessions ranging from improvisation coaching for private teachers to adjudicating non-competitive piano festivals with literally thousands of student entries; from offering personal, intensive master class sessions at all levels to lectures in advanced composition. Everywhere he goes, his fresh and uplifting approach to music never fails to inspire and enlighten all who attend.

Norton is presently writing a series of commissioned pieces. Most recently, he has written a very well received *Jazz Piano Sonata* and has recently published, through his own new publishing venture, www.80dayspublishing.com, an *Italian Suite* for 2 Pianos, a *Turkish-Anatolian Suite* for 2 pianos and an *Idaho Suite* for solo piano.

Christopher now lives, with his wife Wendy, another composer, in Stratford, Ontario, Canada.



Caitlin Boyle – Upper Strings

A Hamilton based violin and viola performer and pedagogue, Dr. Caitlin Boyle currently holds a one-year position as Viola Lecturer at the University of Western Ontario, as well as being a member of the Isabel String Quartet, quartet-in-residence at Queen's University. She has toured and performed extensively across North America and Europe as violist of the Cecilia String Quartet, a position she held from 2006-2018. In 2015 she received her Doctorate from the University of Toronto, where she researched non-verbal communication in string quartet performance.

Dr. Boyle's passion for music education has led her to teach at the Faculty of Music at the University of Toronto, Mooredale Youth Orchestras, Cardinal Carter Academy for the Arts, Taylor Academy at the Royal Conservatory of Music, Festival of the Sound Music Scores Program, Toronto District School Board, Central Okanagan School District, in addition to teaching students across the US, Spain, UK, Italy, and the UAE. She also co-founded Xenia Concerts, events tailored for and welcoming of families living with autism. She has performed with orchestras such as the Toronto Symphony Orchestra, the Munich Symphony Orchestra, and the Schleswig-Holstein Orchestral Academy, and now holds positions with Sinfonia Toronto and the Niagara Symphony Orchestra.

Chris James – Woodwind

Canadian flutist **Chris James** is a highly versatile young performer. Praised by the New York Times for his "brilliant" orchestral playing, Chris enjoyed a stellar freelance career prior to joining the VSO. In addition to positions with the Memphis, Missouri, and Ann Arbor Symphonies, he has appeared with the Buffalo Philharmonic, the National Arts Centre Orchestra, the National Ballet of Canada Orchestra, the Michigan Opera Theater Orchestra, and the Detroit, Toronto, Albany, and Nashville Symphonies, among others.

Also an active chamber musician and soloist, he has performed in such diverse venues as New York's Weill Hall, Toronto's Mad Bean Café, the Canadian Museum of Civilization and Ontario Legislature Buildings, and the open-air Piazza del Plebiscito in Viterbo, Italy. Recent honours include performances at the 9th Kobe International Flute Competition, and an appearance on CBC Music's "30 Hot Canadian Classical Musicians Under 30" (2017). Chris has won prizes at numerous competitions at home and abroad, including the National Flute Association's Young Artist Competition and the Federation of Canadian Music Festivals' National Competition. He has been invited as a recitalist to the Mid-South Flute Festival, the Universities of Memphis and Central Arkansas, various National Flute Association conventions, and concert venues across Canada and the United States.

A dedicated educator, Chris is increasingly in demand as an adjudicator. He has recently served in this capacity at the Mid-South Flute Festival, the Toronto, Vancouver, Ottawa, and Oshawa Kiwanis Festivals, Richmond Music Festival, the Ontario Music Festivals Association's Provincial Finals, Rhodes College, and the University of Michigan.
